In 2004, the ministry incorporated as Wisconsin Christian Campus Ministries with a vision to reach the students across all the universities in Wisconsin. In 2007, a ministry was begun at UW Madison. Utilizing a house that had been associated with a previous ministry known as Koinonia House, His House began its first Bible studies and outreach meetings there. In 2012, ministries at Lawrence University and Ripon College started with full time staff on each campus, followed by UW Green Bay in 2014.

With a passion to see university students enter a personal relationship with Christ, and grow in that relationship to become a follower of Christ in every area of life, the staff of His House fervently serve students and faculty on each campus.
